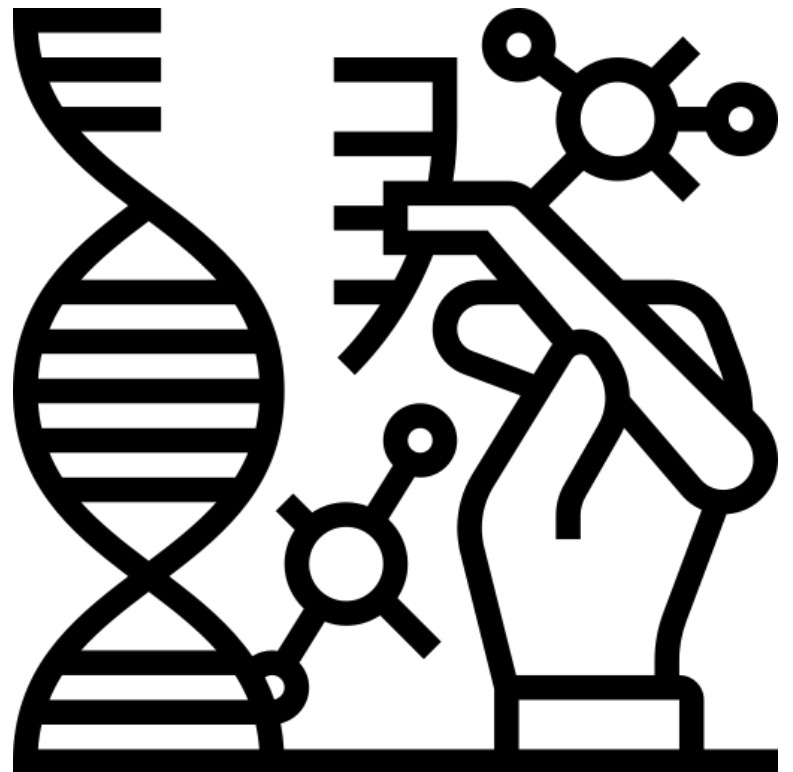
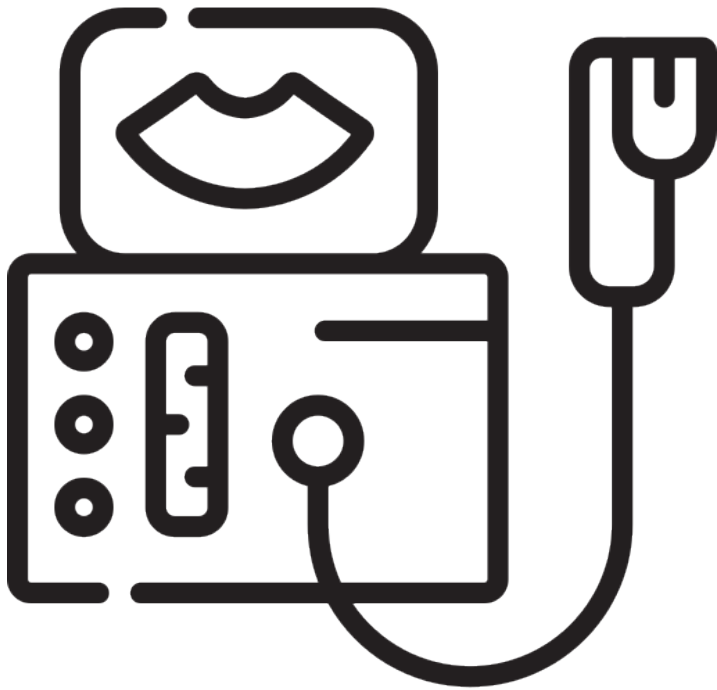


A Genetic Counselor looks to identify family risk for a number of genetic conditions.

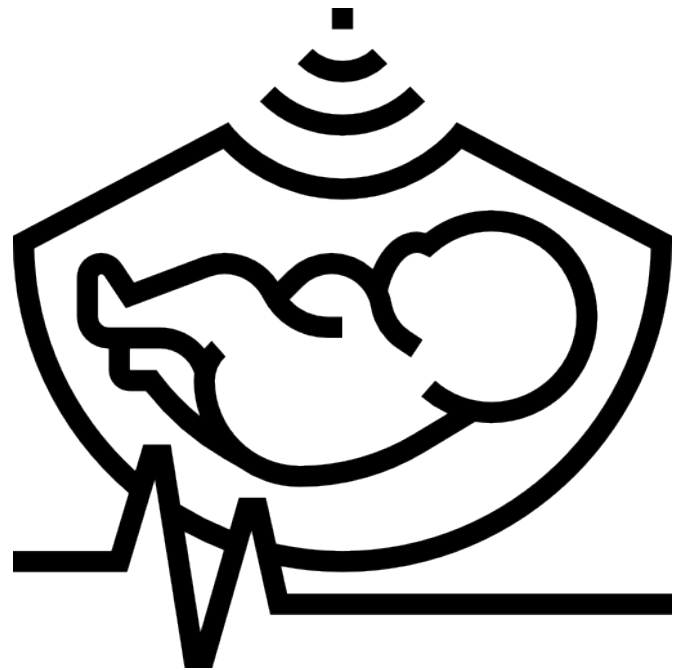
They educate families and provide disease risk assessment and support.





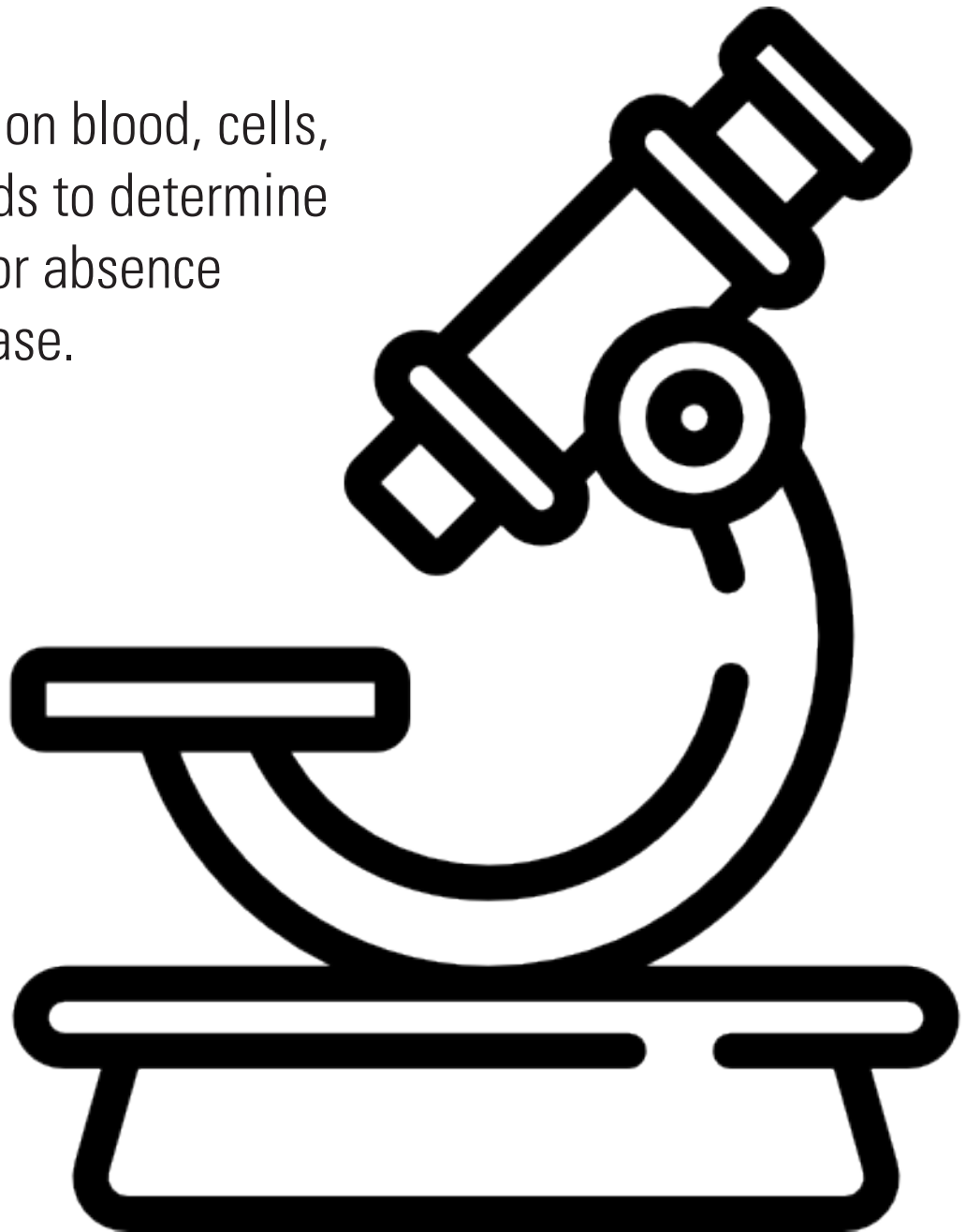
An ultrasound uses soundwaves to create digital images inside your body.

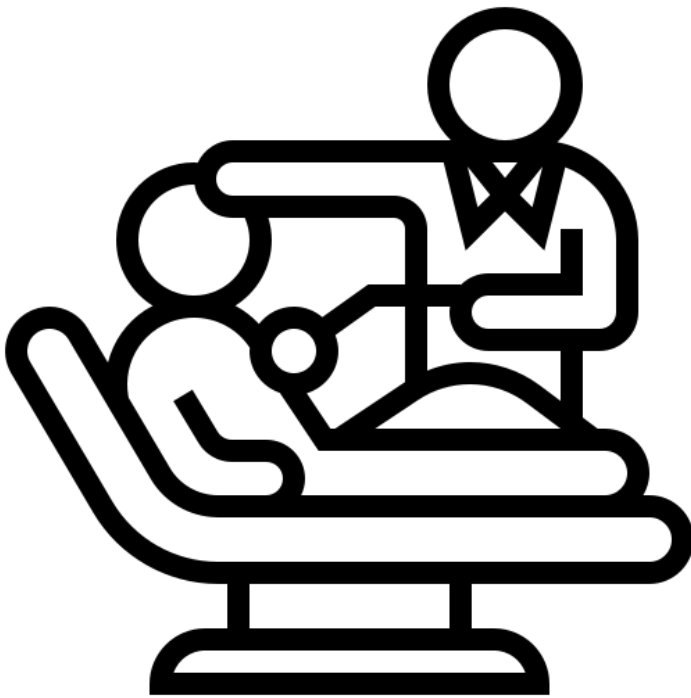
Ultrasounds are not painful, but the pictures can help radiologists see what is causing your pain.
