**Primary Duties and Responsibilities:** UNMC Center for Reducing Health Disparities is looking for a part-time health disparity federal work-study or student worker. This position will provide hands on, “in the field” learning opportunities through health equity and/or health disparity projects. In this capacity, the student will serve as an activity leader for prescribed health disparity projects, assist with data gathering and analysis of health disparity needs, assist with communications, and mobilize key stakeholders to address health equity and/or disparities in the community.
