

Nebraska Area Health Education Center

- The Nebraska AHEC Scholars Program held a virtual statewide workshop for Scholars across the state that focused on interprofessional education.
 An interprofessional panel consisting of a physician, pharmacist, nurse, radiologic technician, and physical therapist shared about the importance of leaning on all members of a team when providing patient care and the benefits of practicing in rural or underserved areas.
- Over 60 AHEC Scholars will graduate in June from the 2021-2023 cohort. AHEC Scholars is a two-year supplemental program for health professions students interested in working in rural and underserved areas.
