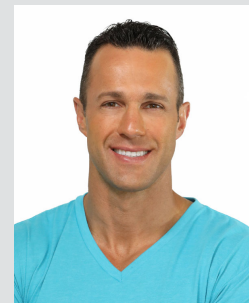
Overview:
