Request for Pilot-Project Applications

Program Summary: The CONDA Center is pleased to announce a funding opportunity for Pilot-Projects. The CONDA Center is a NIH/NIGMS supported Center of Biomedical Research Excellence (CoBRE) that focuses on the cognitive neuroscience across the lifespan and strives to support and develop neuroscience research in the region.

The goal of the Pilot Project Program is to provide support to promising research led by faculty at CoNDA participating institutions (UNMC, UNO, Creighton & Boystown). Applicants must not have concurrent funding from other IDeA programs (INBRE, other COBRE or CTR).

Relevant Areas of Research: This mechanism aims to support innovative, collaborative projects in the field of neuroscience in general with emphasis on the cognitive neuroscience in development and aging in health and disease.

Successful applicants (up to 4 candidates) will receive up to \$50,000 in direct costs per year for 1-2 year. Funding for second year will be competitively reviewed, requiring demonstrated progress and need.

Applications that propose the use of the CoNDA center Research Cores (Neuroimaging core or Translational Imaging & Behavior Assessment Core) will be prioritized. Preference will be given to those proposals likely to lead to submission of Research Project Leader proposals to the CONDA CoBRE.
